Typ 3

- a. If Jim **hadn't drunk** (not/to drink) so much last night, he **would have left** (to leave) the pub earlier.
b. If he (to leave) the pub earlier, he (not miss) the last bus.
c. If he (not miss) the last bus, he (to come) home much earlier.
d. If he (to come) home much earlier, he (to find) his wife in bed with another man.
e. If he (to find) his wife in bed with another man, he (to kill) him.
Drinking can save people's lives!

Typ 2

- f. If Hank **studied more** (to study), he **would do** (to do) better at school.
g. If he (not/do) so badly at school, he (can/to go) to university.
h. If he (to go) to university, he (to get) a better job later.
i. If he (to get) a better job later, he (can/to afford) a big house with a garden.
j. If he (to have) a big house with a garden, he (not/to have) time for anything, because he (must) mow the lawn (*den Rasen mähen*), clean the house and repair the house regularly.
Studying too much only means more work!

Typ 1

- k. If Karen **doesn't hurry up** (not hurry up), she **won't get** (not/get) to work in time.
l. If she (not get) to work in time, her boss (to be angry).
m. If her boss (to be angry), he (give) her more work to do.
n. If he (give) her more work to do, she (can) show him that she can do better than he thought.
o. If she (do) better than he thought, she (be promoted = *befördert werden*) soon.
Sometimes it's better to slow things down a little bit!

b. had left, wouldn't have missed c. hadn't missed, would have come
d. had come home, would have found e. had found, would have killed
f. didn't do, could go h. went, would get i. got, could afford
j. had, wouldn't have, would have to l. doesn't get, will be angry
m. is angry, will give her n. gives, 'll be able to o. does, will be promoted
